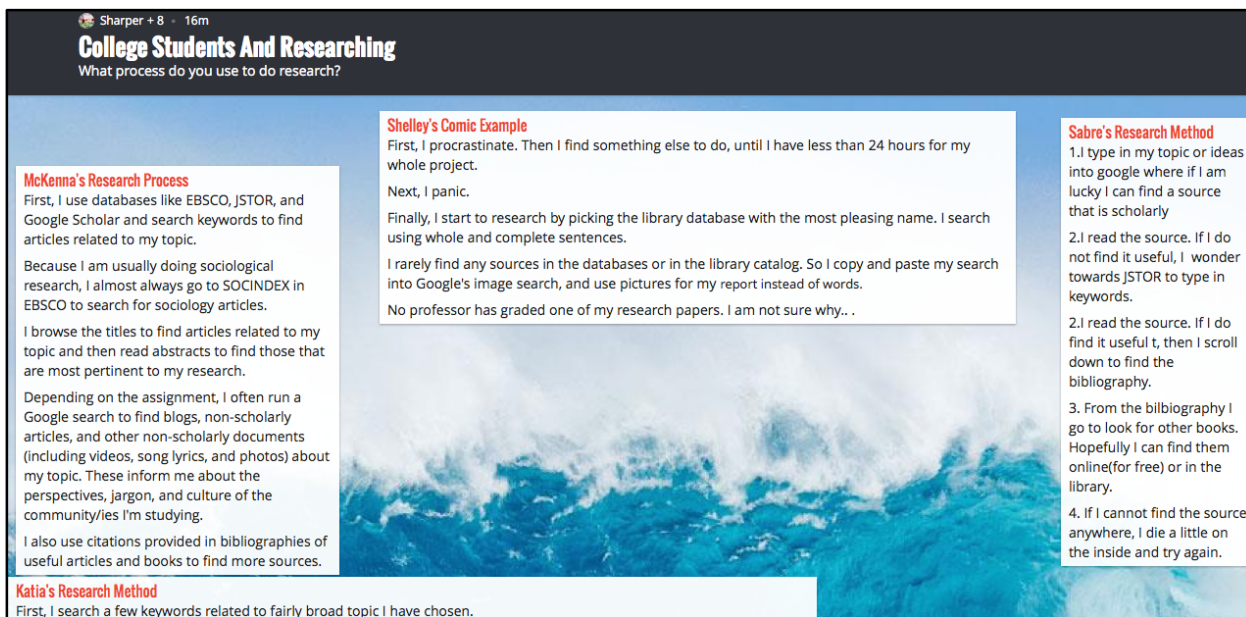


Padlet for Assessment

Padlet provides a centralized, mobile devices friendly, multimedia repository that is intuitive to use. Students do not have to download anything in order to post, and it is flexible so that it can be used in several ways to enable assessment.

Padlet is a cloud-based bulletin board using “walls” that can be formatted to your specification. Create a separate wall for each class, and upload your own images for the background if you wish.

Padlet:	Good Points	Drawbacks
