



## **Prospector Annual Report 2020**


The Prospector union catalog has entered its twenty first year of operation and continues as a key service for supporting fifty libraries in the Rocky Mountain region. This year has been one of the most unusual in recent history marked by a global pandemic, political unrest, natural disasters and a teetering economy. At the beginning of the pandemic virtually everything closed and Prospector was shut down. It was restored for digital lending after about a month into the pandemic. Over the summer and into the fall all libraries were restored in Prospector except for CU Boulder and The University of CO at Colorado Springs. This is primarily due to staffing issues related to the pandemic. It's likely that both will return to Prospector later in 2021. Restrictions and closures due to the pandemic has resulted in lower circulation at libraries and has had a ripple effect on Prospector where fulfillments are down nearly 50% since last year.

One bright spot in this challenging year has been the agreement between the Colorado State Library, Alliance and Innovative Interfaces to add the Statewide Interlibrary Loan System (SWIFT) to Prospector. SWIFT, which uses OCLC's VDX software, includes nearly 150 public, academic and special libraries. Over the course of this year, SWIFT libraries will be migrated to INN-Reach, the Prospector platform. This is great news as nearly all Colorado libraries will now be in one collective resource sharing system.

This year the primary focus will be to successfully integrate SWIFT libraries into Prospector. This will require different implementations as there are several non-III libraries that will be added through the Resource Sharing Broker (RSB) and other Sierra and Polaris libraries that can be directly integrated into INN-Reach. We anticipate that Prospector fulfillments will remain low until there is a vaccine for Covid-19 and restrictions on gathering in groups and travel have been lifted.

We will also continue to focus on digital lending this year by working with e-resource vendors to include ILL provisions in our Alliance group contracts. We also want to explore controlled digital lending and home delivery through Prospector as an "opt in" for interested libraries. Digital lending has been on the forefront for a few years now, but is even more important this year than ever as it's more difficult to lend physical items due to the pandemic.
