SWIFT Migration: A Very Brief History October 2020 - present



Plan: Migrate @150 SWIFT VDX Users to Prospector

Several distinct user groups and paths identified:

Direct connections to Inn-Reach/Prospector

6 Marmot Sierra libraries

API Direct to Inn-Reach/Prospector (D2IR)

3 Polaris libraries

75 AspenCat public, academic, special & correctional libraries

Resource Sharing Broker (RSB) connections

36 Public, community college, and Federal correctional libraries staff initiated only

29 Public, community college, and correctional libraries Full Borrowing & lending



SWIFT, formerly known as Statewide Interlibrary Loan Fast Track, is a statewide interlibrary loan (ILL) service for libraries of any size or type, allowing patrons to search and place requests for materials located throughout the state of Colorado. The service was originally launched using the OCLC VDX software in 2000 but as of January 1, 2021, the service migrated to Innovative Interface's INN-Reach software, joining the Prospector service of the Colorado Alliance of Research Libraries. The SWIFT/Prospector merger will include close to 200 Colorado libraries, comprised of academic, public, correctional, and special libraries. Welcome to SWIFT

SWIFT, formerly known as Statewide Interlibrary Loan Fast Track, is a statewide interlibrary loan (ILL) service for libraries, allowing patrons to search and place requests for materials located in member libraries throughout the state of Colorado. The service was originally launched using the OCLC VDX software in 2000 but as of January 1, 2021, the service has migrated to Innovative Interface's INN-Reach software, joining the Prospector service of the Colorado Alliance of Research Libraries. The SWIFT/Prospector merger will include close to 200 Colorado libraries, comprised of academic, public, correctional, and special libraries.

State Statute:

SWIFT was first brought to Colorado through state statute and is part of Colorado Library Law: Part 3: 24-90-302 Colorado Virtual Library - creation - components - access.

The library (CVL) shall have the following components:...

- (a) A connection to the online-catalogs of the holdings of Colorado libraries;...
- (e) An interlibrary loan system facilitating resource sharing throughout Colorado;...





- Migrate all 23ish correctional facilities to D2IR as borrowers and lenders
- Continue working to bring final remaining 13ish RSB libraries online
- Migrate all RSB users to the Sierra web interface from the Millennium interface
